



Sketchworks Covid Compliance Plan 2022

In order to keep our staff, students, and associated communities safe and healthy during the Covid-19 pandemic, Sketchworks Comedy will be implementing the following precautions:

For in-person classes:

1. Students are required to provide a negative Covid test at least 72 hours prior to the first day of in-person class. If vaccinated, students are asked to provide proof of vaccination as well.
2. At the beginning of in-person class, students will complete and sign the Covid Survey and have their temperatures taken.
3. Masks are recommended, but not required.
4. Hand sanitizer will be readily available.
5. Before and after class, chairs, tables, and door knobs will be wiped down.
6. At least one coach who has completed the Covid Compliance Certification Program will be present. For example, [Georgia Film Academy's Compliance Courses](#).

In the event that a student or staff member tests positive for Covid-19, the class will continue virtually for two weeks. If the class requires in-person collaboration, the class will be postponed for at least two weeks. It is highly recommended and encouraged that all students and staff members that were in contact with the individual with Covid-19 be tested for Covid-19.

In the event that only one student has tested positive for Covid-19 and all others have tested negative, that student may choose to continue class virtually, miss class for two weeks, if applicable, or accept a credit for the pro-rated amount. In the event that only the staff member or coach has tested positive for Covid-19 and all students have tested negative, then the class will resume with a sub.

For live shows and showcases: Audiences will be required to wear masks, unless drinking, and provide a negative Covid test and/or proof of vaccination prior to entry. Classes will be kept to a maximum of 12 students.

In the event that a student or staff member tests positive for Covid-19 during the run of a show, class showcase, and/or scheduled filming, the production will halt. The event will be rescheduled at a future date at least two weeks out.
